# What is 98c?

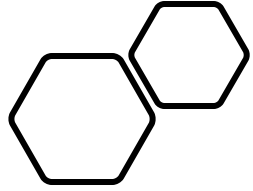
Section 98c appropriates \$52,056,000 in federal funding to address learning loss statewide.

In response to student achievement data, RCS has developed a plan to support students in Reading, Math and Science.





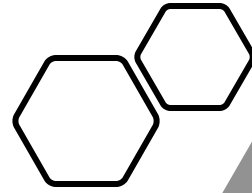
# 98c Fund Usage

The timeline for using this money is narrow

  3. Providing summer learning opportunities



# Administering and Using High Quality Assessments

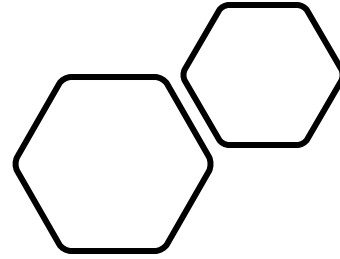


- Roseville Community Schools uses i-READY benchmark assessments for grades K-8 and STAR 360 benchmark assessments for grades 9-12.
