2. Kment Elementary School Removed from Priority School List  
On January 20, 2017 Roseville Community Schools received official notification from the School Reform Office that Kment Elementary School was released from the Priority School status. In 2012 Kment was placed on the Priority List. Kment applied for a school improvement grant and was awarded over \$4,000,000 over three years.

Through the tireless work and dedication of the teaching staff to improve their school, the test scores raised them to the 20% ranking this year.
