In addition to professional growth in Science, Al partakes in professional development to best assist middle school students in today's world. Over the years, he has sought training for himself in CHAMP's, to help make his classroom a safe, inclusive, and productive environment for kids.

Being one of the leading teachers for, and in the use of, Restorative Practices as a proactive measure for students, Al is able to maintain a positive and energetic classroom where students feel cared for. He understands that students learn differently, and at different paces. In addition, Mr. Schwehofer opens his doors and plans for the specific use of Interventionists in his class to assist struggling students, while at the same time pushing those that need to be challenged.

Mr. Schwehofer has taken a very active role at Roseville Middle School for many years. He is a long-time science department chair, providing valuable input into initiatives being implemented. With the support Al provides to his colleagues, the department is easily one of the most collaborative in the building.

As a former school improvement co-chair, Al understands the importance of school improvement, and diligently works to make the educational changes necessary to meet the ever-changing demands placed on students. Al has always exhibited extreme professionalism with each challenge. He regularly attends after school events, and serves on school committees, such as the Restorative Committee. Mr. Schwehofer's dedication is evidenced by his teaching practices. He is a valuable asset to Roseville Middle School and a true leader within the building.

## Sara Stark

Any good teacher of students with cognitive impairments strives to ensure their students have a functional level of independence, so that they can go on to be successful adults in the work place, at home, and in the community. Over the years, Sara Stark has completely transformed the CI program at Roseville High School, empowering students to succeed. They practice life skills regularly, with real-life applications infused into all instruction. As students gain independence and mastery, they practice their skills in the building with various activities and jobs. Sara schedules regular trips in the community so that students have yet another opportunity to practice their skills and demonstrate their ability to apply them to real-life situations.

Both inside and outside of the building, Sara is very intentional when planning student activities. By considering their unique needs and interests, she gets a high level of engagement from her students. At any given time, there could be 5-10 different activities or tasks that need to be accomplished. There is very little down time and always something that needs to be done, which leads to a high level of excitement and motivation.

The CI program has been transformed from a low-level academic program to an incredibly high-level life skills training program. As a result of Sara's dedication to helping students become independent adults, students are thriving in ways unseen in the past. Sara does an exceptional job scaffolding various skills so that the students can become more and more independent. Because she knows her students so well, she can carefully plan activities that will challenge each individual student, but also help them to feel successful. Her students have a wide range of abilities, but she takes great care to make sure that each one learns and grows.

Sara serves as a member of the county-wide cohort of teachers for students with mild cognitive impairments. Through this cohort, she has helped develop curriculum and assessments for schools throughout the county. She has also helped to coordinate the district Special Olympics team, which includes a significant amount of fundraising, planning, and communication with district and parent contacts. Sara is active in planning Roseville High School's transition fair. She collaborated with local districts, combining their ideas with the specific student needs in Roseville, to create a very supportive event for the students and parents alike. Sara also coordinates various staff cohesion activities. Again, she uses her resources within the community to host fun, morale boosting events, with very little budget.

Sara works diligently to meet the academic, behavioral, and independence needs of her students. She implements ideas that will best serve them, going far above and beyond the call of duty to provide resources. Sara has written and earned grants, hosted countless fundraisers, and put in plenty of her own personal funds to make ideas become reality. Her students have greatly benefited from her tireless efforts.
