From the Principal

We need your help! Regular attendance at school equals success for your child. When school is in session, students need to be here, even if it's cold. The state mandates a certain percentage of attendance each day or the school day won't count! Also, our curriculum builds on daily lessons. EVERY tardy and absence can set your child behind.

Students should not arrive to school before 8:30 am unless they are receiving breakfast (8:20). All students will have to wait outside until 8:30. The first bell rings at 8:40. If your child will be late or absent, please call the office before 9 am. There is an answering machine for calls before 8 am, so leave a message as soon as you know if your child will be late or absent. We need to know for lunch counts and the safety of our students. All excessive cases of tardy or absent students are referred to the Macomb County Truancy Office.

Also, our school day ends at 3:30. Please schedule appointments after the end of the school day. We request that students not be signed out early but especially between 3:10-3:30. Please be sure to let your kids know their after school plans (i.e. where to go and who is picking them up) in the morning before they leave for school. Messages after 3:10 are difficult to guarantee getting to your child due to transitioning between classrooms as well as the hustle and bustle of the school day ending.
