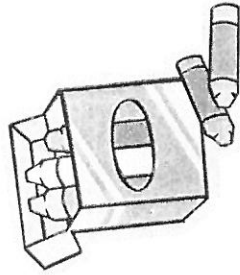
KINDERGARTEN

- Have basic school supplies at home for your child including glue, scissors, crayons and pencils



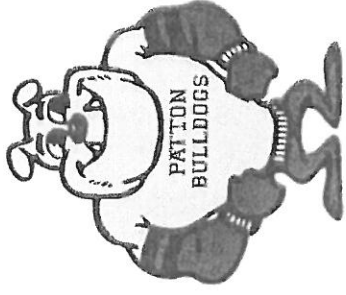
- Bus students - Please write the bus stop on your child's name tag for the first week of school.

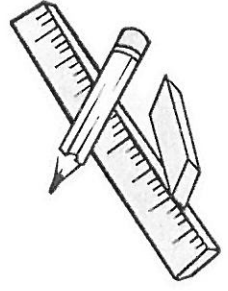
FIRST GRADE
