Dear Parent/Student,

I hope you have had an enjoyable summer and are ready for another productive school year. Orientation for all students was held on August 22, 2016. Thank you to all that attended; we had a great turnout. If you have any further questions, if you weren't able to make it and would like to arrange for a tour, or you would just like to pick up your child's schedule, please contact us.

We are very excited to have your sons and daughters attend Roseville Middle School. Our expectations are the same as yours: that every student at Roseville Middle School takes full advantage of the facilities, technology, activities, committed staff, and all around potential for a high quality middle school education. As a parent of a student, know that as a Wildcat, your child will be constantly challenged to achieve their highest potential. One of the biggest ways we can be successful at that is working as a team in school and at home. Have conversations with your children about what they learned in school each day, what happened at school, and never listen to the excuse that there was no work to do at home on a daily basis. We cannot ensure that students will take advantage of the opportunities middle school presents without the involvement of the most important people in their lives: you. We are willing to partner with every individual parent or guardian to assist in guiding those who resist guidance and educating those who resist knowledge. The middle school age can be a struggle at home and at school; by using the roadmap laid out by the school, and by reinforcing the importance of education at home through discussion, requiring that your child study some materials for even an hour every night, regardless of if they have homework, or simply making your child aware we are communicating, we can create a truly successful individual with character and strength, enough to guide them through high school and beyond.

*Our Bell Schedule – Please note the **new start time** for school this year!*

The first day of school is Tuesday, September 6<sup>th</sup>. This day is a half day and students will be dismissed at 11:00 am. **All parents and students, please be aware that we have a new start time this year. The first bell will ring at 7:40 a.m. and class will begin at 7:45 a.m.** Beginning on Wednesday, September 7<sup>th</sup>, the normal school day will run from 7:45 a.m. through 2:50 p.m.

### Transportation

To qualify for transportation, Roseville Middle School must be your home school and you must live 1.0 miles or further from school for 6<sup>th</sup> grade and 1.5 miles or further from the school for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade. If you have any questions regarding specific transportation issues or your qualifications, please call 586-445-5699.

### Student Drop-off and Pick-up

Do not drop your student off in the bus loop off Barkman. That lot is reserved for buses only. **Please use the Martin Road lot to ensure your children's safety.** No streets have to be crossed if you drop off in this lot and we have crossing guards in the parking lot. Do not drop your child off on Martin Road. Please see the enclosed map of drop-off and pick-up areas.

Bused students that are dropped off in the bus loop or those walking from the 11 mile or Gratiot area must enter the building through the front Barkman doors. Students dropped off by parents in the Martin Road lot must enter through the North Martin Road doors. Students are not to walk around the building to another door.

**Please pull up as far as you can in the Martin Road lot and things will go very smoothly.** Don't stop at the entrance; we have several hundred students that get dropped off and it will make the line longer. Remember to allow 5-7 minutes for the drop off procedure. People who are dropping off or picking up students that do not observe these rules can and have been ticketed. Please note that dropping students off late to avoid the rush will result in Homeroom attendance problems.

### Breakfast and Lunch

Breakfast and lunch will be served on the first full day of school. Roseville Middle School, along with Dort, Huron Park, Kaiser, Kment, Patton, and Steenland, will be participating in the Michigan Department of Education's Community Eligibility Option this fall. Breakfast and lunch will be free for all students in these buildings. No lunch applications will be required for these students. **Please note, if you have students in non-participating schools a free/reduced meal application will be required.** Also, students must take a full meal to receive free benefits; if they only want specific components, such as milk only, they will have to pay the ala carte price for that item.
